# **PASTOR'S PEN:**

#### **The Seventh Commandment**

You shall not steal.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God that we do not take our neighbor's money or property or get it by dishonest dealing, but help him to improve and protect his property and means of income.

Some wealthy people, including two high profile TV actresses have been charged with felonies. They have been accused of bribing college officials, to admit their children to very prestigious universities.

In our legal system, a person is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. Whether or not anyone is convicted, this disturbing news points to other documented and proven cases of theft. In this particular instance, adults have been accused of stealing away opportunities that would allow more qualified students to attend the university or college of their dreams.

That's why these headlines refer us to the 7<sup>th</sup> Commandment... You shall not steal. We know all too well that the rich and powerful steal from the less fortunate. We also know that accumulating wealth is not a sin. Misusing it is.

Career thieves wind up behind bars. It is folly to think they can steal and get away with it. Yet, we continue to see this on a regular basis.

It is more than just money, property and opportunities that are stolen from others. Let's look at some of those ~

- We steal from others, good names and reputations, by gossip and lying.
- We steal from ourselves, when we fail to recognize our faults and confess our sins.
- We steal peace and comfort from ourselves when we don't pray.

Christ dies for all our thefts. In Christ you receive forgiveness of sins. He restores honesty in you. By his power and grace he does what Luther describes in the second half of the commandment from the Small Catechism ~ "in Christ, you don't rob your neighbors nor take from them by unfair dealing or fraud, but help them to improve and protect their property and means of making a living."

Now that is keeping the 7<sup>th</sup> Commandment.


